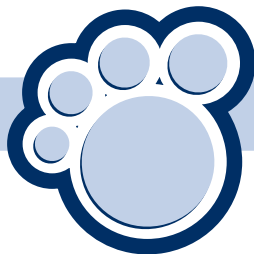

Simply fill out the information on the flip side and return it with a check made payable to BARCS.

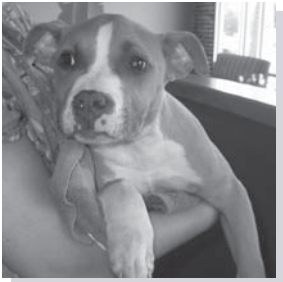
Even the smallest donations make a difference:
